Ministry Model

- By partnering with "known" leaders in the church space, Worship Circle's proven small group model gives leaders everywhere an opportunity to be mentored by someone they look up to.
- **Problem:** Churches often put talented people onstage before allowing them to grow in the security of their beloved-ness first. **Solution**: WC creates space for leaders to grow in secure attachment to God and others thereby drawing those they lead in their lifetime into the awareness of God's love and presence.
- Our **Key Distinction:** High profile leadership team; safe, soul-care virtual environments; in person REST retreats and experiences

Program Evaluation:

We have found that 10-12 Coaches/Small groups is the ideal number to provide the best experience for all. At this number, and adding Worship Circle Pastors groups, we can mentor 750 Pastors/Worship Leaders over the next 3 years.

Growth Strategies:

- Launch TWO **WORSHIP CIRCLE PASTORS small** groups in 2024 to impact lead pastors
- Launch FOUR WORSHIP CIRCLE PASTORS small groups in 2025
- Add more REST Retreats in strategic US regions to draw leaders into small group
- Engage more global leaders through 2023 live recording and maximize YouTube channel (currently at 227k subscribers with over 45 million views)

Current State of US Pastors

- 38% have thought of quitting full time ministry
- 1 in 3 pastors is considered "healthy" in terms of well-being
- the challenges of leading a church in light of the pandemic
